October 3, 2011	Budapest, cruising the Danube ½ day tour of Puszta
October 4, 2011	Vukovar (Osijek) Tour Osijek and experience Croatian life while meeting students during a school visit.
October 5, 2011	<b>Belgrade</b> You'll be taken on a panoramic drive through Belgrade, which features the Belgrade Fortress in Kalemegdan Park, St. Sava Cathedral, and a visit to Tito's Memorial
October 6, 2011	Kostolac (Viminacium) Resident archeologists bring the historic grandeur of the excavations at Viminacium alive. The former Roman city boasted villas, thermal baths, a mausoleum, and even an amphitheather

sequence of gorges that the mighty Danube cut through the

Carpathian Mountains and one of the most dramatic natural displays of

beauty in Europe.

Visit the legendary Medieval Baba Vida Fortress and Belogradchik, a fairytale world of weathered red sandstone in fantastic formations

and one of the natural wonders of Bulgaria.


