Dr. Bradley J. Dibble, MD FRCPC, FACC

(Cardiology)

Dr. Dibble graduated from University of Western Ontario in 1990 and stayed in London Ontario to complete training in Internal Medicine followed by Cardiology. He then completed a 6 month position as a Clinical Assistant for the Department of Cardiology at Victoria Hospital. He started his practice in Barrie in 1996, and joined the team at Southlake in 2000 where he works in the Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory. Dr. Dibble has a broad-based practice in clinical cardiology, with a particular interest in preventative medicine and risk factor modification. He is the regional spokesperson for the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Ontario, and is often on radio and television discussing cardiovascular issues. He is also the Physician Lead for the Division of Cardiology and the Clinical Director of the Cardiovascular Program at RVH, helping to bring advanced cardiac care to the region.

Dr. Anil Gupta is Staff Cardiologist at the Trillium Health Partners. He is the Medical Director of the Coronary Care Unit and Clinical Cardiology for the Trillium Health Partners and the Innovation Lead for the Cardiac program. He has been an active member of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee, Medical Quality of Care Committee and Medical Education Committee. He is the Founder and Co-Chair of the Smoking Cessation Program at Trillium. Work this program has been presented at National and International meetings on smoking cessation.

He is a Lecturer at the University of Toronto and an active member of the teaching staff for the Mississauga Academy of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine, University of Toronto.

He currently serves on Telefilm Canada's Talent Fund and is a cardiology consultant to Tennis Canada and Basketball Canada.

He is the Past President of the Trillium Health Centre Medical Staff Association, served on the Medical Advisory Committee and a member of the Trillium Health Centre Board of Directors.

Dr. Gupta has been a Council member on the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and the Canadian Cardiovascular Society (CCS). He is the Chair of Continuing Medical Education for the Greater Toronto Area Community Cardiologists (GTACC) and Chair of the Trillium Health Centre Cardiology Education Committee.

He served on the Canadian Hypertension Society Guidelines Implementation Committee (CHEP). He was a panelist for the CCS Fitness to Drive/Fly Consensus Document, CCS Peripheral Artery Disease Consensus Document and the CCS Antiplatelet Therapy Consensus Document.

Dr. Marjorie Robb is a psychiatrist working in Ottawa, ON. After an early career as a teacher, she attended Dalhousie Medical School and went on to study psychiatry at the University of Ottawa, where she did fellowships in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Psychotherapy. She is currently the Medical Director of Mental Health Outpatient Services at the Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario, after spending many years in community practice working with adults and youth. Dr Robb's areas of specialization include treatment of mood and anxiety disorders, treatment of trauma, and personality disorders. Dr. Robb is Director of Psychotherapy Training for the University of Ottawa's Child and Adolescent Psychiatry residency program. She has a passion for teaching residents and medical students and for developing shared care. She leads CHEO's Dialectical Behaviour Therapy program for multiproblem adolescents and their families, and does research on adolescent DBT. She has also been engaged in physician and staff wellness projects for many years.
